- -Question asked Why do small plants no longer take Industrial Wastes?
Responses were Liability, cost, smaller plants don't want to deal with it. There are problems with storing in the winter time.
Pricing ranges from 31/2 cents to 71/2 cents
-Wyoming won't take Industrial wastes any more.
- Problems with Linko system
 - mistakes with SNC calculations
 - \$1000 or more maintenace fee a year.
 - Problem calculating TTO
 - detection limits too high can't tell if industries are compliant or not.
