Need to see the bigger picture

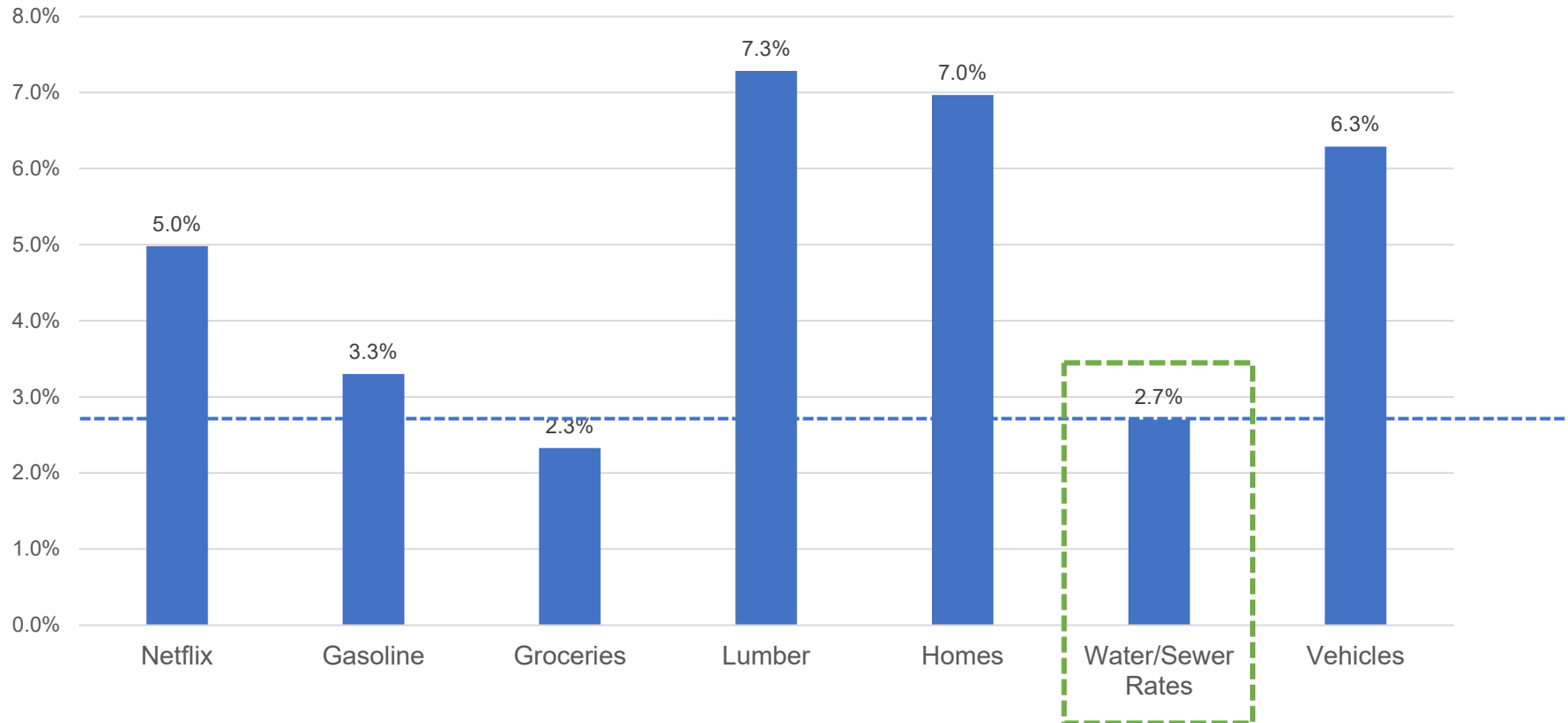
Increase community knowledge and interest

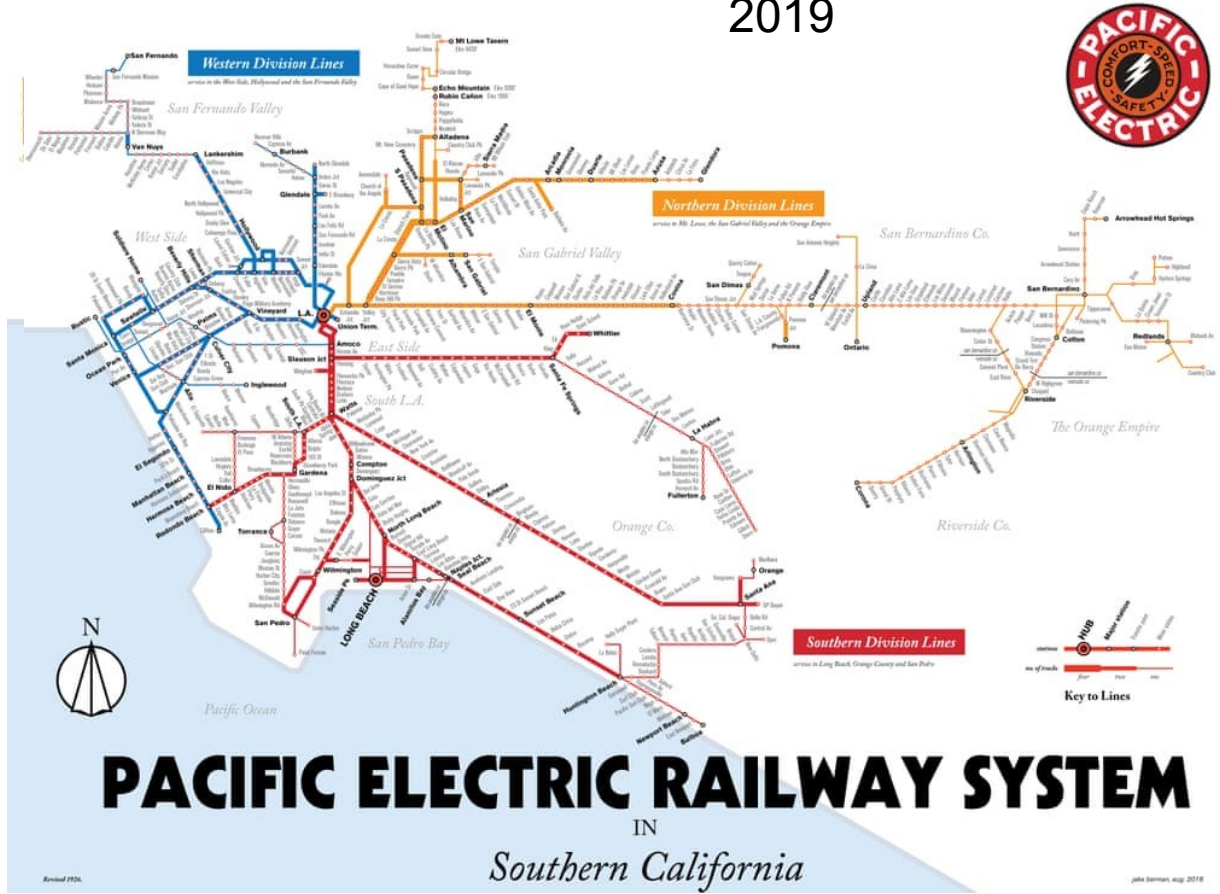

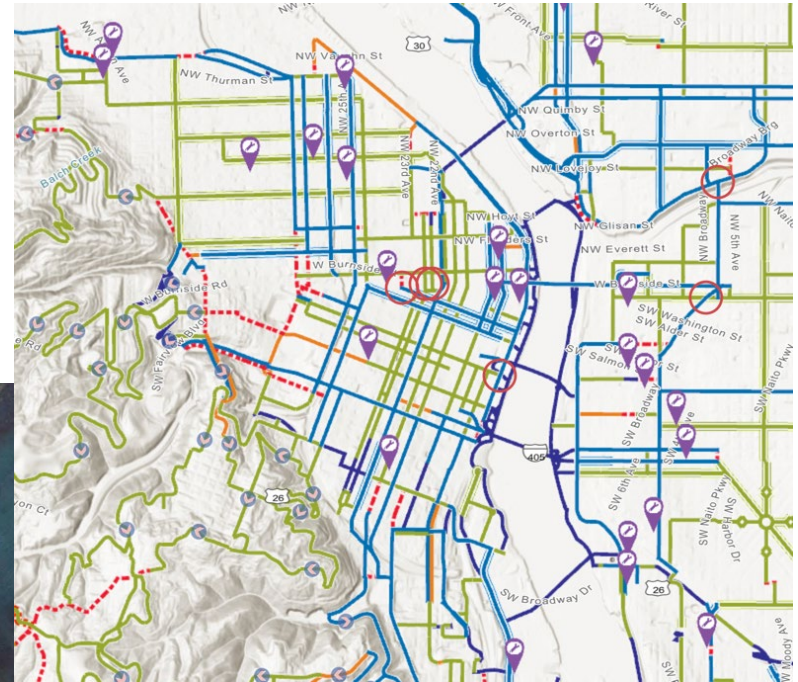
